Donald Lucas is currently the Deputy Director for the Environmental, Health, and Safety Division at the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, and performs research in the Environmental Energy Technologies Division at LBNL and the School of Public Health at the University of California, Berkeley. He received a B.S. in Chemistry from the Illinois Institute of Technology, and a Ph.D. in Physical Chemistry from UC Berkeley. His current research involves the production, detection, and health effects associated with combustion emissions, especially from nanoscale particles. He was an author on the SB521 report to the Governor of California that recommended a ban on MTBE in gasoline. He works with the California EPA and Air Resources Board as a scientific peer reviewer and with their Multi-media Working Group.
