Bob is a Certified Safety Professional and has served on the Board of Directors for the local Chapters of the American Society of Safety Engineers, the American Industrial Hygiene Association and the American Heart Association. He has served as a Steering Committee member for Organization Resources Counselors and has served as the Program Chair for the Aerospace Section of the National Safety Council. From 2000 to 2007, Bob was appointed by the Governor to the State of Washington Industrial Safety and Health Advisory Board where he represented the aerospace industry sector and has also served as a member of the State's Safety and Health Impact Grants Review Committee.
