Sara Hoover is a Research Scientist Supervisor and the Chief of SAABS in the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment, which is part of the California Environmental Protection Agency. She holds master's degrees in chemistry and environmental health sciences. Ms. Hoover has done research in the area of human health risk assessment since 1988. The primary focus of her work has been carcinogen hazard identification and dose-response assessment. She has carried out cancer and noncancer risk assessment research projects on a wide variety of topics including: workplace hazardous substances, pollutants associated with gasoline use, flame retardants, pharmaceuticals, persistent compounds in breast milk and fish, and defense-related chemical compounds. Ms. Hoover is currently involved in California's new programs on biomonitoring and green chemistry. She is also overseeing ongoing work on occupational health risk assessment in collaboration with the Occupational Health Branch in the California Department of Public Health.
